In whatever way this day may be destined to unfold, our intention is to explore our "Quality of Beingness" together, as we continue to nurture a Culture of Peace. We will all weave our love and gratitude for the waters with our collective wisdom, harmony, beauty, reverence, power and resilience. **Directions to CorUnum/the Yurt property:** From Victoria, take Quadra Street heading north, which turns into West Saanich Road after you cross Wilkinson Road. As you continue on West Saanich Road, you will be looking for a right turn onto Old West Saanich Road. Continue on Old West Saanich Road until you reach a 3 way fork in the road. As you will be remaining on Old West Saanich Road, take the middle road at this 3 way fork. Continue following Old West Saanich Road until you see the number 5990, where Old West Saanich Road intersects with Killdeer Road. Turn left onto Killdeer Road. The very first driveway on the left is the driveway for CorUnum. As you drive slowly past the garden and the house, to the right of a Grandmother Cedar tree, you will see a parking area on your right. Please park to ensure plenty of room for others. In the event the parking area is full, there is more parking accessible a few meters further down Killdeer Road. A footpath leads to the Yurt and there will be a wagon available if you have a lot to carry.
